- 11. **Gathering around the Gospel:** On 11.17-18.24, 203 souls came to worship in the early service, 144 in the late service, and 28 in the Monday evening service.
- 12. **Offerings of thanks to the Lord:** From 11.17.24, \$13,900 was given toward the General Fund (\$19,200 needed each week to meet our projected income, \$21,900 needed to meet all projected ministry expenses), \$10,000 toward debt reduction, \$5,000 toward LES tuition assistance, \$314 toward the "Ammo Box" effort, and \$1,500 toward Growing Forward.
