- 7. **Pioneer Wreaths**: The Pioneer wreaths have arrived. You can pick them up at the shed across the parking lot after services and bible class. - 8. **Gathering Around the Gospel:** On 11.24-25.24, 165 souls came to worship in the early service, 120 in the late service, and 30 in the Monday evening service.
- 9. **Gifts of Love to Jesus:** From 11.24-25.24, \$12,300 was given toward the General Fund (\$19,200 needed each week to meet our projected income, \$21,900 needed to meet all projected ministry expenses), \$1,000 toward the School Fund, and \$250 toward Faith for the Future.
