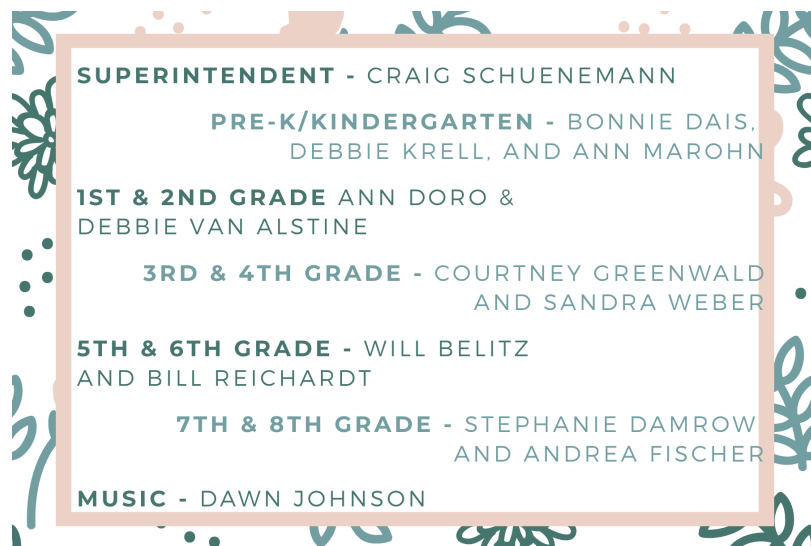

- ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION** - St. Paul's will celebrate its 160th anniversary on September 18th in both Sunday services. We have invited Rev. Tom Unke (our former pastor) to preach that day. There will be a light breakfast served between services with historical displays. Dick Stoelb will also give a brief presentation on the history of St. Paul's. After the late service, we will enjoy a picnic (food provided by Three Guys and a

Grill). There is no cost for the meal, but a free-will offering will be collected to defray the costs. - 2. Did You Know?** In 2001, 20.2 acres of land were purchased on Millersville Ave. for our existing church and school building. Construction began in 2002. The last worship service held at the Playbird Rd./Hwy 32 church building was June 8, 2003. Our new church building was dedicated on June 29, 2003. We are thankful for 160 years of God's grace at St. Paul's and look forward to celebrating with you next Sunday!
- 3. Sunday Bible Study:** Today we continue our unit on Anniversary Reflections, reflecting on the history of the early Christian Church, the Wisconsin Synod, and St. Paul's, as we prepare to celebrate our congregation's 160th anniversary. Last Sunday, we looked at what builds and strengthens our congregation. Today we will gather in the gym to consider how God expands the church.
- 4. Sunday School** - The theme for Sunday School this year is "Built on the Rock". Classes begin today between services. Printed informational pamphlets available as well. This morning in our early service, the Sunday School staff will be installed. May the Lord richly bless their efforts this year!



- 5. Child Care** - We offer child care for children who are too young for Sunday School in the Kindergarten room during Bible class. Parents who utilize the Sunday morning child care take turns staffing it. Please speak with Pastor Bode if you have questions.
- 6. This Sunday** is the last Sunday we include a livestream option. After this we will no longer live stream the 8:00am service. Please note the 8:00am service is still recorded and uploaded to our website by 11:00am! That allows us to prioritize in person worship where possible, as well as allow for video/podcast options very quickly thereafter. [This is also a major improvement from pre-Covid. People used to have to wait until Tuesday to view this on cable TV.] If you have questions or comments, please speak with Head Elder Eric Eickhoff or the pastors.
- 7. Office Hours** - Now that school is back in session, the office hours are Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.. Arrival, 8:00 a.m., and dismissal, 3:30 p.m., are the busiest times during the day. - 8. Mass Choir for Anniversary Service:** We are hoping to have a large mass choir sing for the church anniversary services on 9/18. You don't need to be part of the adult choir to participate! We will have one

9. **World Religions Study** - Join Staff Minister Luther Curia Tuesday evenings at 6:30 beginning September 6 as we examine the basic teachings of Christianity and compare them to the teachings of other world religions. This course will establish basic patterns that flow through all non-Christian religions. With this basic understanding as a foundation, class members will focus on four non-Christian religions: Judaism, Islam, Buddhism, and Hinduism. These four were chosen because of the greater likelihood of class members meeting and having the opportunity to witness to people of these religions. Application exercises are weighted with questions about the Jewish and Muslim religions as most North American Christians have the most contact with non-Christians from these religions.
10. **Contented Parenting Bible Study** - As a parent, do you ever wish you could just stop worrying and fixating on things you can't control? Jesus gave us the key, and it all has to do with our focus. When our focus is on the world, worry is usually the result, but when we focus on Christ . . . well, that changes everything.
