
COMMUNION

When Christ, who is our life, appears, we will appear with him in glory.


Why do you look for the living among the dead?

let this be known to all the world.


⁶Shout aloud and sing for joy, people of Zion,

Second Reading


1 Corinthians 5:6b–8

The angel and the living Lord appear to the women to proclaim Jesus' victory and take away their fears.


¹After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb.





Lord's Prayer


