Whether you're new to the Formula of Concord or have studied it before, this Bible study promises to be an enriching experience for all.

- Divine Call Received On May 21, Pastor Bode received a divine call to serve as associate pastor at Eastside
 Lutheran Church in Madison, WI. Eastside is a congregation of a little over 600 members with a school of


Post-game: fireworks at the ballpark, kids can run the bases, return to St. Paul's
