This weekend, we will look at Article IX of the *Formula of Concord*, which focuses on Christ's Descent into Hell. We confess it often in the Apostles' Creed. When did it happen and why? There was confusion on it in the 16<sup>th</sup> century and there still is today. More importantly, there is great comfort in this teaching of Scripture. Come and learn more in the Harvest Room between services this morning.
