- A general theme for the basket (movies, man cave, date night, relaxation, crafts, sports, super heroes, hunting/fishing, home décor, children's, etc.) We would ask, if possible, but not necessary, you email us with your group's idea in advance so that we can let you know if another group is doing something similar just to avoid overlap and ensure a great variety.
- A basket value in the \$50 - \$100 range.
- Please include a description of the contents of your basket and its estimated value.
- Craft beers or wine have been popular ideas in some baskets. If you wish to include that in your theme, please let us know so that we label the basket accordingly.
- Yes – members from your congregation can put together more than one basket!
- Some congregations have taken a door collection and appointed a member to put a basket together and this has worked well also.
- Baskets can be dropped off in the **MLHS office during the week of Oct 5<sup>th</sup> – no later than Oct. 9<sup>th</sup>. Please make sure they are labeled with name, description and value.**
