

### CHRIST LIGHT CONNECTION

This past week's Christ Light began a series of themes on God's purpose and plan in permitting troubles in the lives of his people. Jacob learned to trust God more as God blessed him through his troubles. We see this theme carried forward into the next couple weeks' Christ Light stories, too, as we continue following the family of Jacob. Jacob's favorite son Joseph falls prey to his brothers' jealousy, and he ends up sold as a slave to an Egyptian official. Joseph continues to live for his God in tough circumstances, though, and God continues to richly bless Joseph. And God's ultimate plan in Joseph's life will become even clearer over the coming weeks.

Troubles and tough times in our lives are opportunities for us also to trust that God is working on something remarkable. To be sure of this, all we need to do is look to examples in his Word like that of Jacob and Joseph, and ultimately the best example of all in his Son's life, death, and resurrection for us.



### ART TO REMEMBER

St. Paul's School is participating in the program - Art to Remember. This is an organization that takes student artwork and prints it on all kinds of keepsakes: coffee cups, key chains, phone covers, coasters, shirts, tote bags, etc.



We decided to involve students in Art to Remember when we realized that we were not going to be able to host our traditional Grandparents Day. We are disappointed that we will not be able to have our special guests this year. However, we wanted them to know that we are still thinking of them. If they can't come to us . . . we will send something to them!

There are 5 steps involved:

- 1) Students create artwork at school
- 2) We ship the artwork to Art to Remember
- 3) Parents receive an order form and code to place orders online
- 4) Orders are delivered to school
- 5) Families distribute keepsakes to grandparents and loved ones



Parents can also order items for themselves. We will be having students complete more than one image. There will be an image for grandparents, and an image for parents and other loved ones. Our timeline will have keepsake items arriving in mid-December for Christmas gifts.



Little Visits With God


