

**LOCKDOWN DRILLS**

St. Paul's School will be practicing emergency response plans in October. We have our low-level lockdown drill today. Our high-priority lockdown drill is scheduled for next week Tuesday, October 13th.

A low priority drill is mostly class as usual with a heightened sense of awareness and some basic safety precautions in place.

A high priority lockdown drill is more intensified. We behave as if there were an immediate danger in our school. We couple our high priority lockdown drill with a practice of our evacuation procedures.

We discuss these situations with each classroom in an age appropriate way. If parents have any questions about our emergency plans, procedures, or how they will be communicated to students, they are invited to contact Principal Marohn.

If you aren't able to attend the Bible study in person but would like to access it online, the Bible studies will be live streamed. They can also be viewed later at these same live-stream links.




**FAMILY DEVOTION MATERIALS**

Read with Me Bible


The Read with Me Bible, NIRV: Children love it. Parents trust it. Children will love reading it with you or to you as you instill a love of God's Word in their hearts.
