Christmas tunes, many of them hundreds of years old, will be played on traditional Irish instruments: guitars, fiddles, drums, harp, cello, tin whistles, uilleann pipes, bagpipes, vocals, and more. The atmosphere of the concert is very casual and follows the ceili format: "an intimate social event at which there is Irish folk music, singing, and storytelling". No two concerts of The Lutheran Ceili Orchestra are the same as the musicians have lyrics and/or melody lines for each tune and then improvise counter melodies and harmonies. The Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) is a program designed to financially assist parents who choose to enroll their child in a private school. Parents who meet income and residency requirements are eligible to receive a voucher to attend a private school like St. Paul's.
